Gross Domestic Product (GDP) - Measures the economic output of a nation's economy

Inflation - Value of money decreases as price level of goods and services increases

Laffer Curve - Shows tax rate v. government revenue to demonstrate the rate of taxation at which government revenue is maximized. Famously drawn on a napkin.

Philips Curve - Shows inverse relationship of unemployment rate and inflation rate

Stagflation - Rate of inflation and unemployment both high
